Eligibility Criteria for WAW Awards Master List Titles

- 1. To be eligible for inclusion on the annual White Awards Master Lists, a book must have been published two years prior to current year (2015 for the 2017–2018 titles).
 - Previously published materials are not eligible.
 - Only books by authors who reside in the United States, Canada or Mexico are eligible for inclusion on the Master Lists.
 - Fiction, poetry and nonfiction are eligible.
 - When considering poetry, less than 10% may be previously published.
 - Graphic novels are eligible but will be judged on the textual portion only.
 - Textbooks, anthologies and translations are not eligible.
 - Serial books (i.e. books which are not complete in themselves but require books either published before or after the current book to complete the story) are not eligible.
 - Books published in series (i.e. books about the same characters but which are complete within themselves) are eligible.
 - Sequels are also eligible.
- 2. National award winning books are not automatically added to the list
- 3. No consideration is given for reading incentive programs such as Accelerated Reader, Reading Counts or Lexile.
- 4. Other criteria considered by the Selection Committee members include:
 - qualities of originality
 - vitality, clarity
 - factual accuracy
 - respect for the reader
 - broad general appeal to and acceptance by children.
- 5. Books are selected for two Master Lists Grades 3-5 and Grades 6-8.
- 6. Books must be nominated for the Master Lists by a member of the Book Selection Committee.
